FOR ADMISSION TO CATHEDRAL HIGH SCHOOL

Take the High School Placement Test

For Cathedral, the HSPT is *not* an entrance exam. There is some benefit of the HSPT for academic assessment, but we use the test primarily for placement purposes. The HSPT is offered on the following dates at Cathedral High School:

Saturday, October 24, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. (student arrival by 8:15 a.m.)

Saturday, November 7, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. (student arrival by 8:15 a.m.)

Saturday, December 5, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. (student arrival by 8:15 a.m.)

Submit Application Materials

- Cathedral application (**Deadline: Friday, December 11, 2009**)—Students may submit an application prior to receiving test results.
- Copy of most up-to-date 8th grade report card and complete 7th grade report card
- 8th grade ISTEP+ scores (when available from student's school)
- Recommendation Forms (**Deadline: Friday, January 22, 2010**)—Two (2) forms to be completed and submitted by current academic subject teacher(s), guidance counselor, and/or principal. These forms are to be mailed or faxed directly to Cathedral by the school personnel.

Participate in the Student Interview (January)

The Enrollment Management Office will schedule an interview for each applicant with parent(s) in attendance. The interview allows us at Cathedral to get to know the applicant. It also gives the applicant and his/her family the opportunity to get to know Cathedral.

Receive an Admission Decision Notification (mid-February)

All interviews will be completed by the time the Admissions Committee meets in early February, and all information relevant to an applicant's file should be received no later than the end of January. **We will mail decision letters near the middle of February.**
