He said no other school had ever earned as many presidential scholarships at one time!

NEW IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION

There are new additions to the required immunizations for the 2010-2011 school year. In addition to the previously required immunizations; students entering preschool or kindergarten must now have two (2) appropriately documented varicella vaccines, separated by at least three months, or physician documentation of disease history, or laboratory evidence of immunity.

Students entering grades 6-12 must have appropriate documentation of the following vaccinations: Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap); meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4 - Menactra); 2 varicella vaccinations appropriately spaced per CDC guidelines, or documentation of disease history, or laboratory evidence of immunity.

Curricular Update

In an effort to appropriately challenge all students academically in grades 1-8, CKS will tweak the daily class schedule. In all grade 1-5 homerooms students will participate in either a “core” group or an “accelerated” group for reading and math. The same will be true for the middle school in the following subjects: Language Arts, Literature, Math, Religion, Science, Social Studies, and Spanish.

The “core” curriculum will be our normal academic class which has proven to be challenging for the majority of students. The “accelerated” curriculum will move more rapidly through material and provide any needed enrichment.

Teachers and the administration will place all students accordingly and as they deem appropriate.
